



The GEA Fund 2017/18

The GEA Fund enters its second year in 2017/18. The Fund aims to support our membership to develop networks and undertake small research projects.

The focus of the 2017/18 Fund is to support pilot work (transcription, travel costs, workshops to bring potential collaborators together) that can feed into the development of a larger research bid.

The planned research proposal must be relevant to a particular national or international priority related to gender and education, and directly support GEA's aims & objectives (<http://www.genderandeducation.com/about/>)

Applications will need to:

- identify policy- and academic-relevance of focus; *and*
- have detailed plans for how the pilot work can feed into a larger research bid (identifying which funder would be targeted).

Criteria that are applied to the Fund more broadly, i.e. applicable each year include:

- All applicants must be GEA members
- Current Executive members are not eligible to apply
- All proposals must include a timeline of activities
- Proposals must also include a breakdown and justification of the project costings
- All funded proposals will be need to produce materials to be shared on the GEA website (<http://www.genderandeducation.com>) (blogs, articles, resources etc.)

Criteria applied by GEA when assessing applications received for the 2017/18 Fund include:

- Ensure a range of issues/interests are covered across the proposals funded
- Ensure at least one funded proposal is from the Global South

£4,000 of GEA Funds have been allocated to this call and we will aim to make 3-4 awards.

Timeline

- Submit proposals (using the template) to claire.maxwell@ucl.ac.uk by 15 September 2017
- GEA to inform colleagues who have submitted a proposal of the outcome by 29 September
